

Ashland Water and Sewer Department
Meeting Notes
July 26, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. Mr. Cilley, Mr. Paquette, and Mr. Toth present.

Rusty Cross reported that Lystek has prepared cost estimates. He will schedule a meeting for an upcoming work session.

Rusty Cross also reported that the water tank has been cleaned.

The estimate for relining 300 feet of the sewer line on Main St. is approximately \$12K. The commissioners approved the project. Relining will be done in September.

The commissioners approved the purchase of MVP CMMS software at a cost of \$1,500 per year.

The commissioners will ask the Select Board what information they will require in order to accept the campground sewer line. Vern Marion is willing to give the town the sewer line between the campground and Washington St. The commissioners estimate that the line is worth between \$250K and 300K based on the current cost of installing sewer lines. The department should own the line in order to ensure that the line and the pump station are properly maintained. Accepting the line will also allow the department to add customers along Winona Rd. in the future.

The commissioners signed the Sansoucy contract. This will be the final contract for engineering consulting for the Northern Pass SEC hearing..

Alan Cilley will prepare the Site Plan application for the Receiving Station. He will also prepare a plan to enlarge the parking lot at 6 Collins St.
