FIRE

Heath started out by telling us that calls are up from last year. At this time last year we had 202, this year 242.

Heath has only two concerns re: his budget going into the 2nd half of the year.

- 1. Contract Service which is down to 27.59%
- 2. Vehicle Maintenance which is down to 28% as of tonight's meeting

The postage line is overdrawn due to the fact that \$58.00 was taken out for the rent of the PO box.

There will be a warrant article for a new fire (pump) engine next year

There is \$125K in capital reserve fund for the fire engine. A new fire engine at this time runs about \$450K.

To finance \$450K (using the \$125K from capital reserves) the payments would be roughly \$76k per year for 5 years including financing.

Batteries for radios need to be ordered

Jaws of life needs to be checked

Battery maintenance to be done on the heart monitor

Everything in the ambulance now has a shelf life. Speare Hospital is one of the very few hospitals that still swap out outdating materials for newer materials.

Ladder truck was purchased in 2006 and is tested every year.

Engine 2 pump failed the pressure test.

The years of the trucks are '87, '94, and '06. The ambulance is a '97.

The dept. is working on staggering buying 2 new protective gear outfits yearly
