	Rusty Cross will contact Dean Marcroft to ask for his assistance to complete the project in the bay of the building at 6 Collins St. It is suggested that the bay project be completed as soon as possible.		
	Dave Toth recommended that all information contained on the present office computer be backed up to the computer in the second floor meeting room.		

Donna Boswick, an accountant with James M. Reera & Co., with is preparing a Memorandum of Understanding for the commissioner's review.

COMMISSIONER'S ISSUES

Ernie Paquette said that he had received a request to install a sewer line from the town beach along Route 3 to the Ashland town line. The commissioners asked that the property owners present a proposal for consideration.
