Board members discussed creating a list of 17 projects from the utility departments and prioritizing the items. Topics discussed were creating a newsletter, promoting the town website, 36 37 and social media (creating a Facebook page), managed by the town officials. **Zoning** – the topic of zoning and code enforcement matters in town was mentioned 38 39 and discussed by the Board.
