



## **Fuel Assistance**

The Fuel Assistance Program provides benefits to qualified New Hampshire households to assist with heating costs. Assistance benefits are a grant that do not have to be paid back and can range from \$210 to \$1,575, depending on the households gross income and energy costs. Benefits are calculated taking into account gross household income, energy costs, type of fuel, number of household members and housing type.

## **Electric Assistance**

The New Hampshire Electric Assistance Program (EAP) gives eligible customers a discount for the first 750 kWh on their monthly electric bills. The discount can range from 8%-76%. The electric assistance program calculates the benefit based on your gross household income size and electricity usage. Our participating vendors are: Eversource Energy, Liberty Utilities and New Hampshire Electric Cooperative.
