Article 4: Support Staff Collective Bargaining Agreement

To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Pemi-Baker Regional School Board and the Plymouth Regional Education Support Staff Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

Fiscal Year	Estimated Increase
2021-2022	\$65,585
2022-2023	\$55,215
2023-2024	\$52,236
2024-2025	\$47,840

and further to raise and appropriate Sixty-Five Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Five dollars (\$65,585) for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)

Article 5: Operating Budget

Shall the Pemi-Baker Regional School District vote to raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Sixteen Million, Thirty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Forty dollars (\$16,036,640)?

Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Fifteen Million Six Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Three dollars (\$15,682,263), which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Pemi-Baker Regional School Board, or by law or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. This sum excludes the sum in Warrant Articles 2, 3, and 4. The School Board recommends this article. (Majority vote required.)
