# Section 4 – Required Inspections

# CALL THE BUILDING INSPECTOR IN ADVANCE FOR AN INSPECTION - 603-968-4432, EXT. 562 Please have your permit number, address, and the type of inspection ready.

The following inspections are required in Ashland as a minimum. *Additional inspections may be necessary, depending upon specific circumstances.* You *must* call the Building Inspector in advance at 603-968-4432, ext. 563, to schedule these inspections before proceeding to the next building phase.

- Underground piping: After related piping is installed and prior to backfilling.
- Rough inspection: After all piping and valves are installed and completed, but *before* any fixtures are installed and before any work is covered or closed in.
- Electrical Permit and inspections may be required for any new installation of appliances. Existing installations (replacement of appliances) must be brought into compliance with current codes at the time of replacement. Replacement of current non-GFCI or AFCI receptacles or circuit breakers with GFCI or AFCI receptacles or circuit breakers does not require a permit, but must be performed by a licensed electrician.
- Final inspection once all work is completed.

# Section 5 – Regulations and Code Provisions

**Plumbing License Requirements:** It is unlawful for anyone to install plumbing work for compensation without a license. Only a licensed Master Plumber or a homeowner using the Homeowner's Exemption below can apply for a Residential Plumbing Permit. Proof of license is required, to be submitted along with your permit application. [*Ref: RSA 153-29*]

**Exemptions for Homeowners:** The plumbing licensing requirement does not apply to "a homeowner of a **single-family** residence owned and occupied by him/her as his/her bona fide personal abode." The exemption only applies if the homeowner is actually performing the work. Homeowners that are issued plumbing permits and then decide to contract with a licensed plumber, for all or a portion of the work, must have the plumber obtain a plumbing permit for the work being done by the plumber. [*Ref: RSA 153-36:I*]

**Plumbing Code requirements:** All installations, regardless of who performs the work, must comply with all New Hampshire and Ashland Plumbing Codes. [ref: 2018 International Residential Code: R105.6 and Ashland Building Regulations Article 41]

*Work commencing before permit issuance:* Any person who commences work requiring a permit on a building, structure, plumbing, gas, mechanical or plumbing system before obtaining the necessary permits shall be subject to a fine established by the applicable governing authority that shall be in addition to the required permit fees. *[Ref: 2018 International Residential Code: R108.6]* 

Any construction started without a required permit or any stage of construction started without the prerequisite inspection(s), or any work performed after a "Stop Work Order" is issued, is subject to a fine of up to \$275 (for the first offense) or \$550 (for each subsequent offense). Each day a violation continues shall be a separate offence. [*Ref.: RSA 676:17*]

Suspension or revocation of permit: The code official is authorized to suspend or revoke a permit issued under the provisions of this code wherever the permit is issued in error, on the basis of incorrect, inaccurate or incomplete information; in violation of any

ordinance, regulation or any of the provisions of this code; or if there have been any false statements or misrepresentations as to the material fact in the application for permit. [*Ref: 2018 International Residential Code: R105.6*]
