The Applicant, Atlantic Tower, LLC proposes to site a Communication Tower and associated facility at the southwestern end of the property next to Interstate 93 and existing overhead utility wires to provide optimal wireless service to Atlantic's FCC licensed customers in the area.

Should a decision not be reached at the public hearing, this application will stay on the Planning Board's agenda until such time as it is either approved or disapproved.

In the case of a public *meeting*, as opposed to a public *hearing*, you are allowed by right to be notified and be present, but you do not have the right to offer testimony except at the Board's discretion.
