NOTICE OF HYDRANT FLUSHING



The Ashland Water Department will be conducting fire hydrant flushing on dead end streets between the hours of 7am and 4pm. The department is introducing a different blended liquid phosphate at the water plant. Blended phosphates are used to prevent corrosion of the pipes and limit dirty water. Flushing is done to coat the pipes with the new blended phosphate. During this you could experience changes in water pressure and may notice discoloration of your water, however, do not be alarmed. Run your cold water until it clears up. Water customers are cautioned to check for discoloration particularly prior to washing laundry. Hydrant flushing is a necessary requirement to maintain safe drinking water for the system. If you have any questions, please contact our office at 603-968-7193.
