presentation with a timeline of events regarding the cemetery trusts. Amanda showed Ashland Town Report pages from prior trustees that showed the accounting of the cemetery trusts back to 1920 all the way to 2007. Mrs. Loud outlined that the cemetery funds are funds that people left so that their grave/stone would be maintained with the interest that was gained off of the original money which was usually around \$50. Mrs. Loud showed that in the town reports prior to 1999 had each individual accounting of who left money for their cemetery spot. In 1999 the Green Grove Trust appeared in the town reports with no date of inception and seemed to combine the 30 or so individual accounts and was invested at Paine Webber. (Amanda noted that the other trusts were all held at Meredith Village Savings Bank or Ashland Savings as it was previously named.) The expenditures of the cemetery trusts had been consistently expended from the early town reports but expenditures stopped around 1994. There was an expenditure in 2001 for \$1,000 however Mrs. Loud made an educated guess that the expenditure was for fees.

Mrs. Loud also showed the correspondence that she had going back to 2020 when she was first elected, surrounding the issues with the Green Grove Trust with the Attorney Generals' Office, Fred Welch who became the Town Manager in 2021, and Town Council. However the process for undoing the issue of the combined funds has not yet been resolved. Mrs. Loud added that the DRA form MS-9 which is to be filed yearly, had not been done since 2007. Herself and the current trustees have worked on the MS-9 filings since 2020, but DRA would not accept their filings due to the outstanding issue with the Green Grove Trust.

Town Council was present for this meeting, Laura Spector-Morgan from Mitchell Municipal was in attendance and spoke with the Board and the Trustees on how to move forward on this issue. Mrs. Spector-Morgan feels that we can get the issue resolved but it will take time to do so.
