52	c. QUESTION OF AGREEING TO A CONTRACT WITH THE STATE FOR
53	GENERATING POWER AT THE SQUAM LAKE DAM – Town Manager
54	Fred Welch discussed with the Board the potential costs of taking the dam over
55	which would be several hundreds of thousands of dollars over the next five years
56	and that the Town would be responsible for all repairs under the lease agreement.
57	The energy production would be very little. Mr. Welch put forth his
58	recommendation that the Board does not pursue the project.

77	will work on getting this completed.
