## ASHLAND PLANNING BOARD ABUTTER NOTIFICATION PUBLIC HEARING

Should a decision not be reached at the Public Hearing, this application will stay on the Planning Board's agenda until such time as it is either approved or disapproved.

Please be advised that as an abutter, your right to testify is restricted to the <u>Public Hearing</u>, You may submit testimony in writing for the Public Hearing. In the case of a public *meeting*, as opposed to a public hearing, you are allowed by right to be notified and be present, but you do not have the right to offer testimony except at the Board's discretion.
