7	I.	CALL TO ORDER – Selectmen Fitch opened the meeting with Selectmen Chris
8		Janosa, Meghan Semiao, Ann Barney, and Charles Bozzello all present.
9		
10	II.	NEW BUSINESS
11		a. PUBLIC HEARING TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS – The Town received
12		grants funds that will help with the replacement of the Police Department radios.
13		There were no comments from the public.
14		
15		MOTION: Chris Janosa
16		To accept the Grafton County grant funds totaling \$19,046
17		SECOND: Charles Bozzello
18		VOTE: 5-0
19		MOTION PASSED
20		
21		b. PUBLIC HEARING: NEW CAMPGROUND RATES – Before the public
22		hearing was opened, the Board went over the new contract that is to be sent to the
23		campers. The Board worked their way through the draft contract and made
24		motions on the changes.
25		
26		MOTION: Meghan Semiao
27		To approve the \$3,800 with payments due in two parts, the first payment (deposit) is
28		due on Columbus Day weekend, along with the storage fees (\$200 per RV, \$200 per
29		boat). After January 1 st , 50% of the deposit will not be refundable.
30		SECOND: Chris Janosa
31		VOTE: 4-0-1 (A. Barney abstained)
32		MOTION PASSED
33		
34		Decks: the Board discussed the allowance of decks so long as they are removable.
35		
36		MOTION: Charles Bozzello
37		To approve one 8X8 storage shed, and one 8X12 deck that is to be in modular 4X8
38		sections (and must be taken down at the end of the season) and for the Building
39		Inspector to inspect the installation. Any special requests from prior campers to be
40		reviewed by the Board of Selectmen and will be enforceable by the Building
41		Inspector.

43		VOTE: 4-0-1 (A. Barney abstained)

46	There was discussion surrounding the registration of campers vs. the taxation of
47	unregistered campers. The Board will require that campers be registered, and the
48	proof of registration must be submitted to the Parks & Rec Director no later than
49	April 1 st in any year.
50	
51	In section 6 of the contract <u>Chris Janosa</u> made a motion which was seconded by <u>Andy</u>
52	Fitch to add the language "Units must have tires, and a hitch attached at all times and
53	be ready for removal in the event of an emergency" the motion passed 4-0-1(A.
54	Barney abstained)
55	
56	In section 9 of the contract Andy Fitch made a motion which was seconded by Chris
57	Janosa to remove the language "The erection of any structure requires the approval of
58	a building permit before erection or construction. The insurance policy shall name the
59	Town of Ashland as an additional insured. Cancellation of insurance automatically
60	cancels the building permit to utilize the campground for the permitted structure and
61	requires removal of the structure under construction." <u>The motion passed 4-0-1(A.</u>
62	Barney abstained)
63	
64	Section 12 of the contract had a motion from <u>Chris Janosa</u> with a motion seconded by
65	Andy Fitch to remove section 12 as it is the same as section 7. The motion passed 4-
66	0-1(A. Barney abstained)
67	
68	In section 16 of the contract Chris Janosa made a motion which was seconded by
69	Andy Fitch to remove the line "Both the boat and trailer must be made inoperable and
70	immovable while stored". The motion passed 4-0-1(A. Barney abstained)
71	
72	Section 26 had a motion by Chris Janosa and seconded by Andy Fitch to combine the
73	section with section 34 and note that "no items are to be fastened to any trees in the
74	campground." The motion passed 4-0-1(A. Barney abstained)
75	
76	Section 28 had a motion by Meghan Semiao and seconded by Chris Janosa to re-write
77	section to read "Sites accommodate only one camper, trailer, or tent. All sites must be
78	kept neat and orderly. Failure to do so will be deemed a rule violation." The motion
79	passed 4-0-1(A. Barney abstained)
80	
81	It was motioned by Chris Janosa and seconded by Andy Fitch to add a section that
82	reads "All outside refrigerators must be approved by the Campground Director and
83	must be kept locked when camper is not at the site." The motion passed 4-0-1 (A.
84	Barney abstained)
85	
86	The Board asked to have the contract sent to the Town's legal counsel for their
87	review and advised Ms. Barney to send out emails to the campers that were in good
88	standing to ask if they would like to come back.
89	
90	The public hearing for the campground rates was opened at 7:34pm. There were

91	many comments from various members of the public throughout the meeting
92	regarding the rules and the rates.
93

95	To accept the rates for the 2025 season at \$3,800 per site for the season, \$200 for RV
96	storage and \$200 for boat storage.
