7	I.	CALL TO ORDER – Selectmen Barney opened the meeting with Selectmen Chris
8		Janosa, Meghan Semiao, and Charles Bozzello all present. Chair Fitch joined the
9		meeting shortly after its opening.

11	II.	NEW BUSINESS
12		a. CAMPGROUND – The Building Inspector Tom Newcomb provided the Board
13		with a memo regarding the Boards previous decision to allow temporary decks at
14		the Campground. Mr. Newcomb explained that its not feasible to allow for
15		temporary decks because temporary decks are not something that is covered by
16		the building codes. By not having a standard to inspect the decks by it would open
17		the Town to potential liability. Mr. Newcomb also shared other safety concerns
18		from when he and the Fire Chief Heath did a site visit. A recommendation was
19		made to the Board to have the sites numbered in accordance with the address
20		numbering system, Mr. Newcomb also shared concern for the placement of the
21		propane tanks and Chief Heath shared concern pertaining to the fire circles and
22		that previously people were moving them. The Board also discussed removing the
23		ability of winter storage on the advice of Town Council.

26		Based on the advice of council, no winter storage will be allowed and no structures
27		shall be permitted with exception to the approved RV's/Trailers.

32		The new rules will be re-written and sent to legal for their review before they
33		will be released to the campers. The Board agreed that if a camper applies to the
34		Campground and upon receipt of the rules they disagree with the rules then any
35		deposit made will be refunded to them.

39		winter storage or structures. Further, if the camper(s) disagree with the rules once in
40		receipt of them, they will be refunded their deposit.
